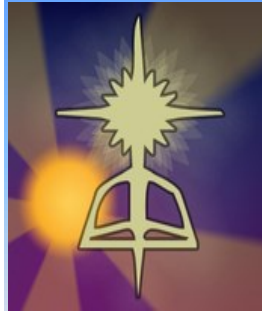

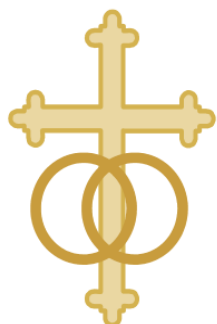
### BRINGING FORWARD THE OFFERINGS OF BREAD AND WINE

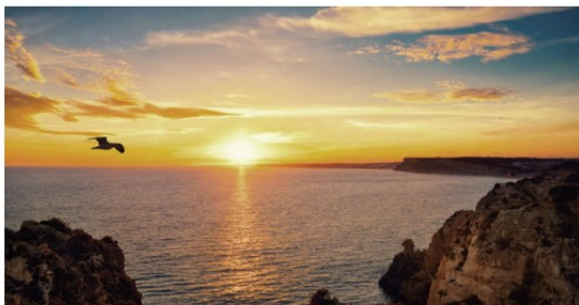

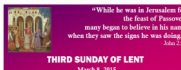

*Jesus said, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you, will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough."*

Luke 13:24

**Isaiah 66:18-21**

This prophecy came at the end of the time when the Jews were living in exile in Babylon. In it, God announces that the Gentile nations will come to know him and his merciful love and glory. He will do this by a startling plan: the nations of the earth will receive "fugitives" from Jerusalem, that is, exiles who have returned home from Babylon who will serve as missionaries. In response, these foreigners will bring back to Jerusalem "all your brothers," that is, all the Jews who had been scattered among the nations. God will even choose priests from among the Gentiles. The good news here is that God's love knows no bounds, extending to all the earth, even to us today.

**Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13**

The author of the letter to the Hebrews explains that, like earthly fathers, God shows interest in us by expecting the very best we can deliver. At times, this involves enduring our trials as a discipline since "whom the Lord loves, he disciplines." Working out at the gym can make us stronger ("no pain, no gain") and the same can be true of our relationship with God. At first, discipline seems painful but later on brings the "peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it." Giving oneself to Christ is no guarantee of a happy or easy life. The author encourages his readers, including us, never to tire of resisting the temptations of the day so to live like Christ which brings true joy.

**Luke 13:22-30**

In this reading Jesus speaks words both of hope and warning, welcome and discipline. He tells us that people will come from the four corners of the earth to the banquet that is the kingdom of God. Just as Isaiah prophesied, God's love and salvation will be universal. But Jesus also warns us that there is a narrow gate to salvation that won't remain open forever. We need to strive to enter through it, remaining vigilant in our Christian walk and not taking the easy way out that the world promises.

**Gospel Reflection Questions....**

*After reading next Sunday's readings and Gospel, take some time to pray on them before you come to Mass. Use the questions below to aid your reflection.*

1. "We ate and drank in your company." Is membership in a particular church an automatic "opening" of the narrow gate? Is the narrow gate open to all of humankind? Can people of all religions receive grace? God is always creating you, moment to moment; do you think God ever stops offering you moments of grace?

2. Pope Francis asks, "What does Jesus mean? Through which door should we enter? And why does Jesus speak of a narrow door?"

"The image of the door recurs in the Gospel on various occasions and calls to mind the door of the house, of the home, where we find safety, love and warmth. Jesus tell us that there is a door which gives us access to God's family, to the warmth of God's house, of communion with him. This door is Jesus himself (cf. John 10:9). He is the door. He is the entrance to salvation. He leads us to the Father and the door that is Jesus is never closed. This door is never closed it is always open and to all, without distinction, without exclusion, without privileges. Because, you know, Jesus does not exclude anyone....

I ask you: are you Christians by label or by the truth? And let each one answer within him- or herself! Not Christians, never Christians by label! Christians in truth, Christians in the heart. Being Christian is living and witnessing to faith in prayer, in works of charity, in promoting justice, in doing good. The whole of our life must pass through the narrow door which is Christ."
